

NAME

`tie` – merge or apply WEB change files

SYNOPSIS

`tie -c|-m outputfile masterfile changefile...`

DESCRIPTION

The *tie* program is used to process multiple change files used with the WEB system for literate programming. The WEB programs allow to apply patches to a source file (the *masterfile*) by means of a number of change files (often only a single change file is allowed). *Tie* can be used to either merge up to nine change files into a single one or to apply the changes to the *masterfile* in order to create a new one. Output of either the new change file or the patched master file goes into *outputfile*.

OPTIONS

- `-c` Create a single change file from the given *changefiles*.
- `-m` Create a new master file by applying the given *changefiles*.
